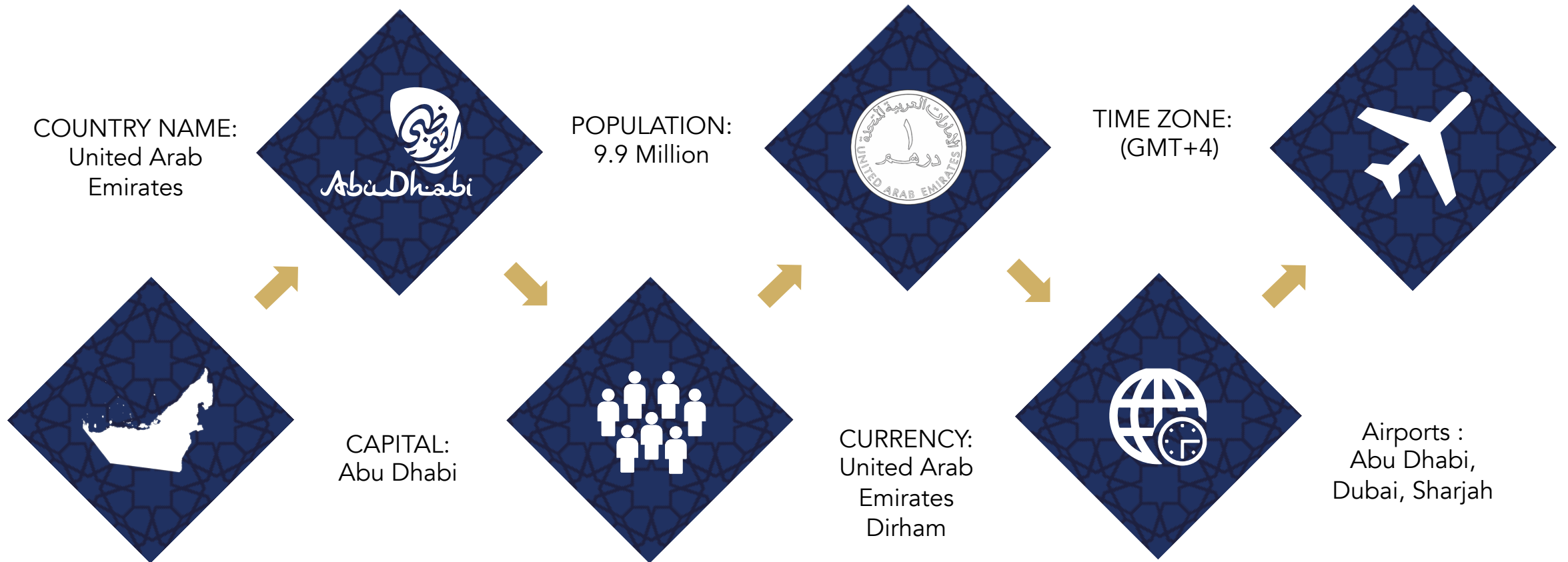

- ✓ Dubai will be hosting EXPO2021.

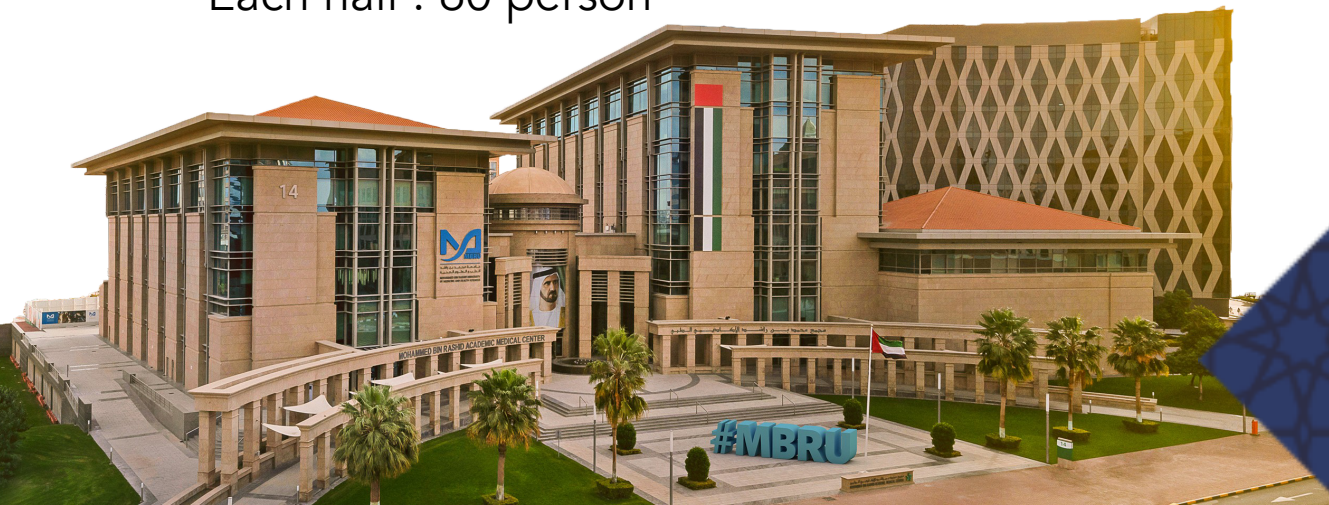

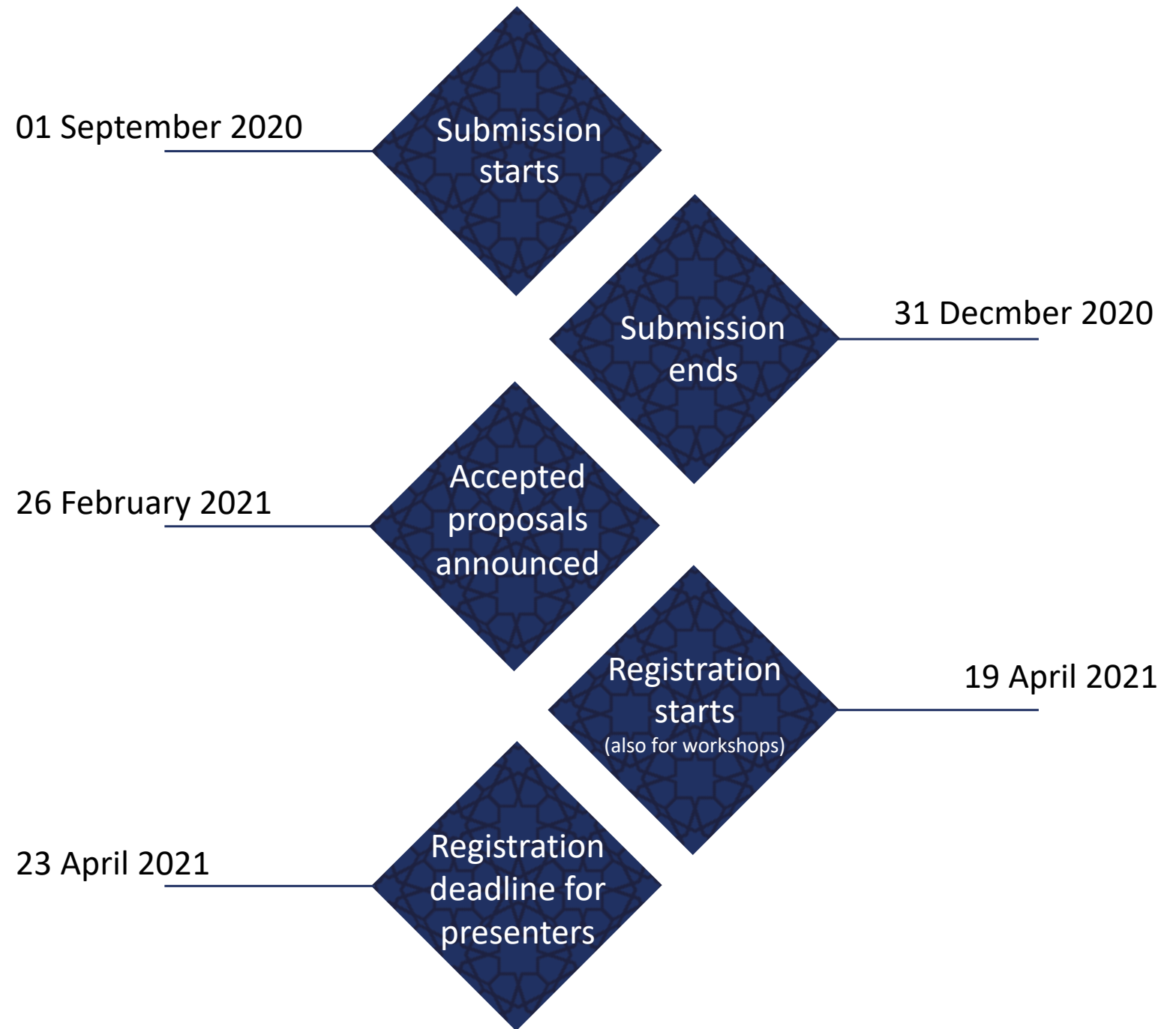

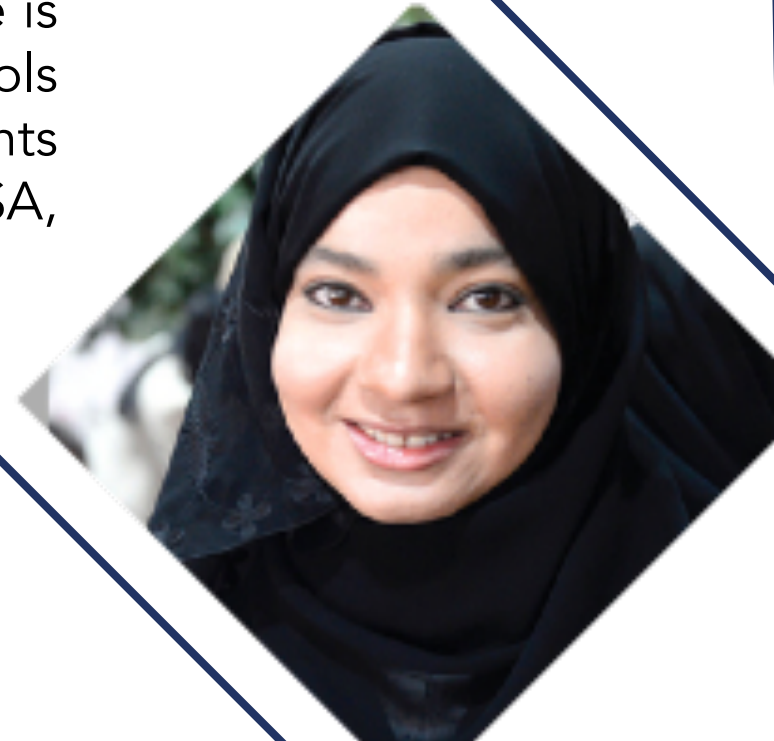
