

Participation Fees for ICCS 2027

November 2023

IEA's International Civic and Citizenship Education Study (ICCS) investigates the ways in which young people are prepared to undertake their roles as citizens in a wide range of countries. Since 2009, the study has reported on student achievement in a test of conceptual knowledge and understanding.

Total Fee:

The international fee per country participating in ICCS 2027 is € 385,000 (euro).

Payment Distribution:

Countries paying the full five-year fee in the first year (2024) are granted a discount of 5%.

Benchmarking Fees:

A benchmarking participant, in terms of applicable fees, is a sub-entity of a country that already participates in the study or the second sub-entity of a non-participating country. The sub-entity must be clearly defined and unambiguously described. In the case of a sub-entity of a country that is not participating and where no other sub-entity is participating, the full participation fees apply. For sub-entities of countries already participating, 20% of the basic fee (as per above) applies. All benchmarking participants will be reported in a separate table of the international report.

Oversampling Fees:

For up to 150% of the minimum sample size, no additional fee is applied. For each 20% (schools) above the 150% of the minimum sample size, an additional 10% fee is applied.
